

We appreciate your support in completing this survey (Time approx. 8min) aimed at determining the collision risk between tourism and pleasure vessels (e.g. sailboats and cruise ships) and some cetaceans in oceanic waters of Colombia (Caribbean - Pacific).

This survey considers your knowledge and experience with these organisms particularly five species of cetaceans, giving them a score based on the risk of collision with vessels worldwide.

To answer this survey, you have to filled out **only** the blue “column A” called "Score" as follows: the idea is you compare which of two species (species 01 versus species 02) present a higher collision risk with tourist vessels such as sailboats and cruise ships. If you consider that species 01 presents a **HIGHER** collision risk than species 02, you must score it with **INTEGER NUMBERS** ranging from 1 to 9. If you consider that species 01 presents **LESS** risk than species 02, you must score it with a **FRACTIONAL NUMBER** ranging from 1/2 to 1/9. Please note the following rating scale:

When species 01 has a HIGHER collision risk than species 02 (integer numbers):

- 1 – The risk is the same for both species
- 2 – The risk is slightly higher in the species 01
- 3 – The risk is moderately higher in the species 01
- 4 – The risk is between moderately higher to strongly higher in the species 01
- 5 – The risk is strongly higher in the species 01
- 6 -- The risk is between strongly higher to very strongly higher in the species 01
- 7 – The risk is very strongly higher in the species 01
- 8 – The risk is between very strongly higher and extremely higher in the species 01
- 9 – The risk is extremely higher in the species 01

When species 02 has a HIGHER collision risk than species 01 (fractional numbers):

- 1/2 – The risk is slightly lower in the species 01
- 1/3 – The risk is moderately lower in the species 01
- 1/4 – The risk is between moderately lower to strongly lower in the species 01
- 1/5 – The risk is strongly lower in the species 01
- 1/6 – The risk is between strongly lower to very strongly lower in the species 01
- 1/7 – The risk is very strongly lower in the species 01
- 1/8 – The risk is between very strongly to extremely lower in the species 01
- 1/9 – The risk is extremely lower in the species 01
