



VETERINARY STUDENT EXTERNSHIP 2023

The Pacific Marine Mammal Center rescues, rehabilitates and releases marine mammals and inspires ocean stewardship through research, education, and collaboration. As part of our mission of education, the Pacific Marine Mammal Center offers a 4 to 6 week externship for veterinary students that provides experience in marine mammal medicine, rehabilitation, husbandry, necropsy and research.

The extern will work under the direct supervision of the veterinarians, as well as assist animal care staff and volunteers with daily care and feeding of the patients. Externs will participate in pinniped (and occasional cetacean) triage, physical examinations, medical treatments, anesthesia, phlebotomy, radiography, ultrasonography, endoscopy and surgery depending on the needs of the patients at the time of their externship. In addition, externs will participate in live animal stranding response and necropsy, including pinnipeds, dolphins and whales.

Externs will be required to complete a small research project. Results will be presented to Pacific Marine Mammal Center staff and volunteers, with the ultimate goal of completing a project that can be presented at a conference and/or published in a peer-reviewed journal.

Applications for the 2023 veterinary externship program (**January 1st, 2023 - August 1st, 2023**) are now open. Students will be scheduled for 4 to 6 week blocks during this period of time. This is an unpaid position and preference will be given to students who will be in their final clinical year of veterinary school at the time of the externship. Travel, housing and transportation will not be provided and is the responsibility of the extern.

Applications are **DUE NO LATER THAN MONDAY, DECEMBER 1st, 2021** and will be reviewed as they are submitted. Students will be notified of their acceptance into the 2023 program on or before February 7th, 2022.

1. Cover letter, including 3 preferred blocks consisting of 4 to 6 weeks (if the student schedule is completely open for several months, please indicate that as well).
